Speaking on the occasion I B.Tech student Rohini spoke and felt that Venkayya did not get the recognition he deserved, Dharani felt in spite of taking birth in poor family he worked in British army at 19 years of age, she told that Venkayya was very much interested in Agriculture and penned a few books on agriculture in 1910. Varsha told that Venkayya became plague inspector and served the society. Kamal Bee spoke about his personal life and told that Venkayya was Gandhian in both letter and spirit walked along with Gandhi and took part in freedom struggle.

Principal speaking on the occasion felt that we all should feel proud that he is from Andhra Pradesh and she felt that he should get recognition beyond imagination. She informed that a postal stamp was issued in his memory in 2009 and 2011. NSS programmee officer John Devanand gave a few inputs about his life. He told that he was a staunch follower of Mahatma Gandhi and studied Geology and told that he was very much interested in Agriculture and that he penned many books on it, paving him in getting membership in Royal agricultural society, England. He died in poverty in1963 forgotten by society.

The national flag designed by him got approval from Mahatma Gandhi, when he took part AICC session at Vijayawada in 1921. He felt that students should draw inspiration from this kind of people in history. Programmee ended with vote of thanks. Teaching, non-teaching, HODs took part.


